What we have achieved over the last 12 months!

Half-moon area conversion was completed at the end of last year. We do hope that residents are pleased with the new design and that the level of anti-social behaviour has reduced, as was intended.

New blossom tree planted on the half-moon green area to celebrate the Queens Jubilee.

Corner of Sandringham Drive and Pinewood Place clear-out! At our request, J&T Property Services removed the shrubs and replaced with bark to deter the build-up of empty bottles and cans.

Improvement to pathway along Oakfield Lane. Cllr Kyle Stealey has submitted a bid to the council department responsible for major works, to pave the pathway and install lighting.

6 extra dog refuse bins - BPRA did a walkabout and have proposed locations for the additional bins which has been passed on to DBC through Cllr Kyle.

Green fund grant – a successful application to the tune of £1,500 for the planting of new trees, with the support of councillor Kyle Stealey and leader Jeremy Kite. Our thanks to those who took part via NextDoor in recommending which trees should be planted across the development in the autumn. We will keep residents informed of the final tree choices!

Worked with Hyde Association to plant new trees to replace the fallen Fir tree.





What we have achieved over the last 12 months!

New 20 mph restrictions across estate

BPRA and Cllr Av are working with KCC to improve road safety with the introduction of 20mph signage and the re-marking of road lines across the development.

Working with First Port to update and maintain the parking area by the shops. A new fence has been erected around the bins behind the shops and the bollards repainted near the shops.

Putting Bexley Park on the map – “Santa on tour” and the open-air cinema held on the Bexley Sports Club green have been well received.

BPRA and DBC in discussions regarding HGV traffic for the installation of the 4G pitches at the Sports club and potential damage to our pavements and roads.

Holding First Port to task in maintaining good standards across the development. This includes repairs to the children's parks and fencing.

Litter picker volunteers! We now have 4 group members regularly walking the development. Why not join us?

ULEZ restrictions. We are monitoring the effect on our roads and KCC will also review at the end of the year.

Anti-social behaviour - the police have been working directly with responsible kids & their parents.

New PCSO - Bexley Park has a new Constable Dan Robinson who works out of Dartford Police hub. Dan is on the left!
